Distinguished Conduct Medal

17th Bn., Machine Gun Corps who died on 20 June 1918 Age 27

Cross of St. George 3rd Class (Russia). Son of Henry and Margaret Wellings, of Station Rd., Four Ashes, near Wolverhampton. Formerly a trooper in the "Carabiniers", he was granted a commission for his bravery in the battle of Messines, Oct.-Nov., 1914. Native of Shrewsbury.
