123rd Bty. 28th Bde., Royal Field Artillery who died on 06 January 1918 Age 28

Served in France from Aug. 1914, until he was killed in action at Langemarck, 6th Jan., 1918. Son of Charles and Emily Lutyens, of Great Amwell, Herts. Born at Hascombe Place, Surrey. Was the first to get his Battery over Vimy Ridge.
